Invitational Program for Secondary School Educators from Indonesia

For 33 years, the Japan Foundation has been carrying out a “Secondary School Educators Exchange Program,” which invites teachers from junior and high schools from across the world to observe the education, culture, and industry in Japan and experience a deeper exchange with school staff.

Under this program, the Japan Foundation is inviting middle and high school teachers from Indonesia for a two-week program starting on Thursday, July 5.

After touring Tokyo, Kyoto, and Hiroshima, the 15 educators will visit schools and cultural and education facilities in Osaka City, to deepen exchange with officials there.

Period of the program: Thursday, July 5 to Wednesday, July 18 (14 days)

Main destinations:

Tokyo: Outer Central Breakwater Landfill Site, New Sea Surface Disposal Site, etc.

Hiroshima Prefecture: Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum, etc.

Osaka City: Osaka Municipal Sakuranomiya High School, Osaka Municipal Imaichi Junior High School, Osaka City Education Center, Osaka Municipal Library, Osaka City Abeno Life Safety Learning Center, etc

Reception: Wednesday, July 11, from 18:30 at the International House, Osaka. (members of the press are invited to cover the event)
