### **Unity in Diversity: From Exclusive State to Collaborating Communities**

The Asia Leadership Fellow Program (ALFP), a joint program of the International House of Japan and the Japan Foundation, has for the past eleven years brought public intellectuals from Asia to Japan to discuss pan-Asian issues in a collaborative setting.
