Guidelines on Logo Use

1. Logo variations

(1) The foundation logo has two basic variations (types A and B). The logo's colors must be either purple and gray or black and white (white only may be used if the background is sufficiently dark).

Purple must be PMS 2665C/DIC F320/C60 M70 Y0 K0 (the proximate color for printing) or R125 G63 B200 (the proximate screen color).

Gray must be PMS Cool Gray 11C/DIC G268/C0 M0 Y0 K85 (the proximate color for printing) or R85 G85 B85 (the proximate screen color).



2. Points to note

(1) The minimum size is 15 mm wide for the type A logo and 25 mm wide for type B.

(2) Any alternation beyond enlargement and reduction is forbidden. The combination and the balance between the pattern and letters must not be

changed.

(3) The prescribed colors must be used when printing color materials.

(4) Use of other colors is not permitted.

(5) The specified margins must be maintained.

(6) The emblems must be clearly indicated, with special consideration given to the color of the background.

The emblem's sleek gracefulness symbolizes freedom from ignorance and prejudice, the dynamism needed to achieve mutual understanding that transcends borders and cultures, and intellectual creativity.

The Butterfly Design

The center of the logo's butterfly design represents Japan. The soft contours emerging from and returning to the center express the foundation's unending desire to serve as a medium for transmitting and receiving culture, art, language, and thought between Japan and of the rest of the world.

The Color Purple
