



17 talented professionals in the performing arts world from Europe, the Americas, and ASEAN countries to visit Japan

The Japan Foundation (JF) will invite prominent figures at the forefront of the performing arts world, including artists, festival and theater directors, and stage directors, to Japan from early to mid-December.

Seven professionals will be invited from seven countries in Europe and the Americas, while a further ten professionals from nine ASEAN countries will be invited in collaboration with the Yokohama International Performing Arts Meeting (YPAM) as part of the comprehensive people-to-people exchange initiative, "Partnership to Co-create a Future with the Next Generation: WA Project 2.0," which aims to promote exchange among the next generation and develop human resources in Japan and ASEAN countries. This invitational program seeks to facilitate exchanges between these professionals and Japanese performing arts experts and institutions. This program is aimed at deepening understanding of Japanese performing arts overseas, facilitating the formation of global networks, and fostering continuous exchanges and new creative collaborations.

The invited professionals are scheduled to participate as speakers in talk events at YPAM, to be held on December 4 to 6 (Wed. to Fri.), as well as on December 13 (Fri.) and 14 (Sat.). For more details about this event, please refer to section 3 below and related websites.
