Outline

This program supports collaborative and dialogue projects that build partnerships between Japan and the U.S. to help resolve policy issues faced by the global community. Collaborative and dialogue projects jointly conducted by Japanese and U.S. institutions working toward solutions to contemporary common challenges that cross national boundaries are eligible for support.

Eligibility

Japanese and U.S. non-profit organizations

Eligible Projects

The projects must begin between April 1, 2026 and March 31, 2027. The following are not eligible for support under this grant: projects focused on academic research in medical, technical or natural sciences, commercial activities, projects in support of specific doctrines or claims. For details, please refer to the "Japan-U.S. Global Partnership" guidelines.

Grant Coverage

A portion of the costs necessary for the project can be covered by this grant. The following are eligible for consideration:

- Personnel & Honoraria (honoraria and staff salary)
- 2 Travel and Per Diem (international and domestic transportation costs, accommodation costs, and meal costs)
- Conference costs (room rental, audio and visual equipment rental, etc.) 3
- Report & Publication costs (editing, website creation, translation, printing costs,
- 5 Other direct project costs as deemed relevant and necessary
- Indirect costs (no more than 10% of the direct costs the Japan Foundation supports)

Selection Policy

- 1 Applications will be selected based on a comprehensive assessment of the project proposal, including topic, purpose, participants, methods, dissemination of outcome, etc.
- 2 Relevant area experts may be consulted during the review process as necessary.
