

## **Imagined Past, Remembered Future**

Between 1999 and 2000, Japan Foundation Asia Center organized a number of Japan-ASEAN Cultural Dialogue Forums in Tokyo, Singapore and Manila—the last being a three-day interdisciplinary workshop entitled, "Imagining the Past, Remembering the Future: War, Violence and Memory in Asia." These gatherings of scholars from anthropology, cultural studies, history, literature, political science and sociology can be read in parallel to the "Under Construction" exhibitions (2001-03) jointly curated by participants from different Asian countries preliminary attempts to confront entangled histories in the region, and to prospect for future-oriented issues to work on together.

"Imagined Past, Remembered Future" is suggestive of the cyclical, the iterative as well as the performative – hinting at mythology, irony, ritual, magical realism, fantasy, speculative fiction, and self-restoration.
