Montien Boonma (1953-2000) was a Thai artist who was very influential in the development of contemporary art in the 1990s. Montien Boonma received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Silpakorn University in 1978, and went on to study sculpture at L'École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris. After graduating in 1988, the artist taught mixed media sculpture at Chiangmai University. Montien Boonma became internationally recognized with his participation in regional exhibitions such as "New Art from Southeast Asia 1992" at Tokyo Metropolitan Art Space and Fukuoka Art Museum (1992) and "the First Asia-Pacific Triennial of Contemporary Art" at Queensland Art Gallery (1993).

Montien Boonma's practice marked a transition from modern to contemporary art in the Thai context. He used rural farming objects, construction material, and traditional herbal medicine in his sculptural practice. The artist's application of Buddhist concepts and traditional techniques into his art-making paved the way for his students and younger Thai artists.
