- Classes: Twice a week

 - *We might open only one class in one of the mentioned times depending on the number of students.

* Available classes will be announced on the day of the interview.

*Make sure to bring your stationary (pencil, pen, eraser...) with you as we will not lend them.

*You may not be accepted to join the level which you wish depending on your test result.

- His/her guardian's agreement is also required.
 (His/her guardian has to come with him/her on the registration day.)

In the Japan Foundation Courses, you will learn grammar, but the courses will focus more on communication and reading. You will also focus on the understanding of the Japanese people and culture through cultural activities.

Therefore, our courses are not recommended for those who only want to study the grammar or to prepare themselves for the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT).
