3. Course

Basic Level Information

- * Current university students majoring in Japanese language <u>**can**</u> register for the following courses.
- ** Time: Twice a week for Level 7-10, once a week for Advanced Pilot class (from Sunday to Wednesday)
 6:00 pm 8:00 pm
- *** Each class must be with more than 10 students. In case there were less than 10 applicants, the class will not be

offered.

**** Contents of the Advanced Pilot Class <u>may change</u> if applicants were less than 10.

- 1 Level 7
 - Prerequisite: Completion of the study of Japanese Language Beginner's Level.
 - As well as reviewing what was taught in the Beginner's Level, students will study communication, grammar, vocabulary, expressions and kanji necessary for advancing to the Intermediate Level.
 - Textbook: "Marugoto Shochukyu A2/B1"
- Level 8
 - Prerequisite: Previously studied the textbook "Marugoto ShoChukyu A2/B1" or a textbook of the same level.
 - The objective of this level is to raise the students' Japanese language proficiency in general by building upon the basis of what is taught in the textbook "Marugoto ShoChukyu A2/B1", and to increase their repertoire of grammar, vocabulary and expressions. There are exercises on speaking, listening, reading and writing about certain themes, in order to raise the students' Japanese communication skills.
 - Textbook: " Marugoto Chukyu 1 B1"
- ③ Level 9
 - Prerequisite: Completion of the Intermediate Japanese Course Level 8/ those who have previously studied the textbook "Marugoto B1" (Topic 1-5) or a textbook of the same level.
 - The purpose of this course is to increase the learners' repertoire of grammar, vocabulary and expressions. There will be exercises on speaking, listening, reading and writing about certain themes, in order to raise the learner's Japanese communication skills.
 - Textbook: "Marugoto Chukyu 1 B1"(Topic 6-9).

- ④ NEW! Level 10
 - Prerequisite: Completion of the Intermediate Japanese Course Level 9/ those who have previously studied the textbook "Marugoto B1" or a textbook of the same level.
 - The purpose of this course is to increase the learners' repertoire of grammar, vocabulary and expressions.
 There will be exercises on speaking, listening, reading and writing about certain themes, in order to raise the learner's Japanese communication skills.
 - Textbook: "Marugoto Chukyu 2 B1"
- ⑤ NEW! Advanced Pilot Class
 - Prerequisite: Students who passed N1 or N2 of JLPT or at the same level and want to improve their Japanese skills.
 - Teaching Materials: a wide range of teaching materials (newspaper articles, short stories, movies, etc.)
 - Contents: Aim to enhance the students' Japanese language skills, learning Japanese language not only through the textbook but also through the various aspects of the language and enhancing the understanding of Japanese people and culture.

For students of 16-17 years of age

- All of our courses are designed for adults (above 18 years).
- If a 16 or17-year-old student wishes to join our course, submission of <u>a copy of his/her ID card</u> or <u>birth certificate is</u> required on the application day and a copy of the guardian's ID card is required on the payment day.
- His/her guardian's agreement is also required.

(His/her guardian has to come with him/her on the registration day.)

In the Japan Foundation Courses, you will learn grammar, but the courses will focus more on talking, reading and communicating. You will also focus on the understanding of the Japanese people and culture through culture activities.

These courses are not recommended for those who only want to study grammar or to prepare themselves for the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT).
