#### 2022 Tuesday, March 8 The Eternal Breasts

Directed by Tanaka Kinuyo Based on the book by Wakatsuki Akira, Nakajo Fumiko 1955 Nikkatsu 110min B&W 35mm SETTING: Sapporo and surroundings in the early 1950s. The Eternal Breasts is based on the diary of a newspaper reporter, Wakatsuki Akira, which described the life and poems of the poet Nakajo Fumiko. The film is one of the few examples in Japanese cinema where the life of a mature woman was put on film by a woman scriptwriter and director of the same age.

### Wednesday, March 9 Girls of the Night

Directed by Tanaka Kinuyo Based on the novel by Yana Masako 1961 Toho 95min B&W 35mm SETTING: Tokyo around 1960. Japan finally banned prostitution in 1958. Institutions were created to help reform these prostitutes, but as working from the novel by Yana Masako, society itself seems unwilling to let them reform. Tanaka Kinuyo's direction seems to suggest, is for the women to cleanse themselves on their own.

## Thursday, March 10 **CLOSE-KNIT**

Directed by Ogigami Naoko 2017 Suurkiitos 127min Color Blu-ray Director Ogigami Naoko, whose many fans adore the uniquely soothing atmosphere in films like Kamome Diner. The protagonist has undergone a sex change to become a woman and lives with her partner and his young niece.
