

How to use the IRODORI Japanese Online Course



【Good examples】

- In the classroom, show learners the course videos, problems and other contents on a monitor.
- For online classes, share the course site onscreen to show course videos and practice listening, among others.
- Share downloadable materials from the course—such as vocabulary lists and grammar references—with learners, or print them out for distribution.
- In the classroom, conduct classes using textbooks, such as the Irodori: Japanese for Life in Japan, then ask learners to use the study contents and practice contents in the course to prepare and review.

How to use the IRODORI Japanese Online Course



【Bad examples】

- Shoot videos of lectures or classes using the course, and then publicly post them on YouTube, Facebook or other sites.
- Record and stream online classes conducted using the course.
- Create teaching materials or resources by taking screenshots of problems, illustrations or other materials on the course.
- Duplicate course problems or other materials to create problem workbooks.
- Print out practice contents or quiz pages on the course to distribute to a class.
