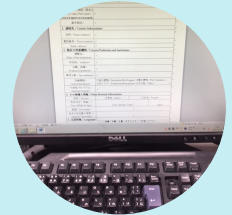

Ability to attend lectures & participate discussions in English. Japanese skill is also preferable

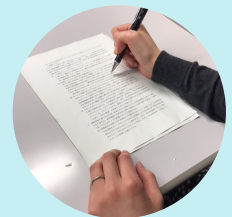
- Main Contents:
